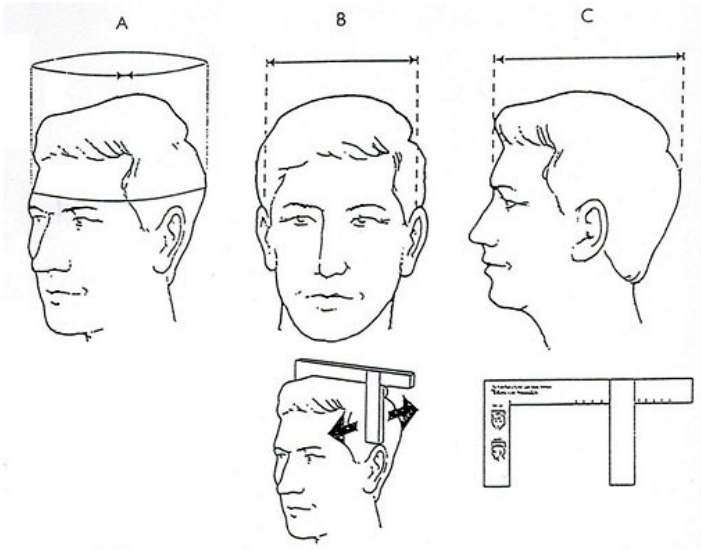




## ALPHA 900 KESTREL & ALPHA 900 FALCON SERIES HELMETS



1. For Measurement 'A' use a tape measure around the head in position shown.
2. For Measurement 'B' & 'C' a Head Measuring Calliper will be required. These are available from Helmet Integrated Systems Ltd on request.
3. For Measurements 'B' & 'C' ensure the callipers are pressed against the skull. Slide the callipers back and forth to locate the maximum measurement.

Helmet Size	Measurement 'A' Circumference (mm)	Measurement 'B' Head Width (mm)	Measurement 'C' Head Length (mm)
Medium (M)	550 - 580	142 - 164	180 - 203
Medium Long (M/L)	577 - 620	147 - 164	201 - 218
Medium Broad (M/B)	577 - 605	160 - 175	180 - 203
Large (L)	590 - 622	160 - 175	201 - 218
Extra Large (XL)	600 - 640	168 - 180	212 - 224

Both comfort and retention are key to selecting the correct size of helmet. Should a head size fit into two options, the smaller size of helmet should be selected wherever possible.

If any of the measurements enter the range for the next largest helmet then that is the size that should be selected.

For example: (A = 592mm, B = 162mm, C = 200mm) = Medium Broad (M/B)  
 (A = 592mm, B = 162mm, C = 206mm) = Medium Long (M/L)
